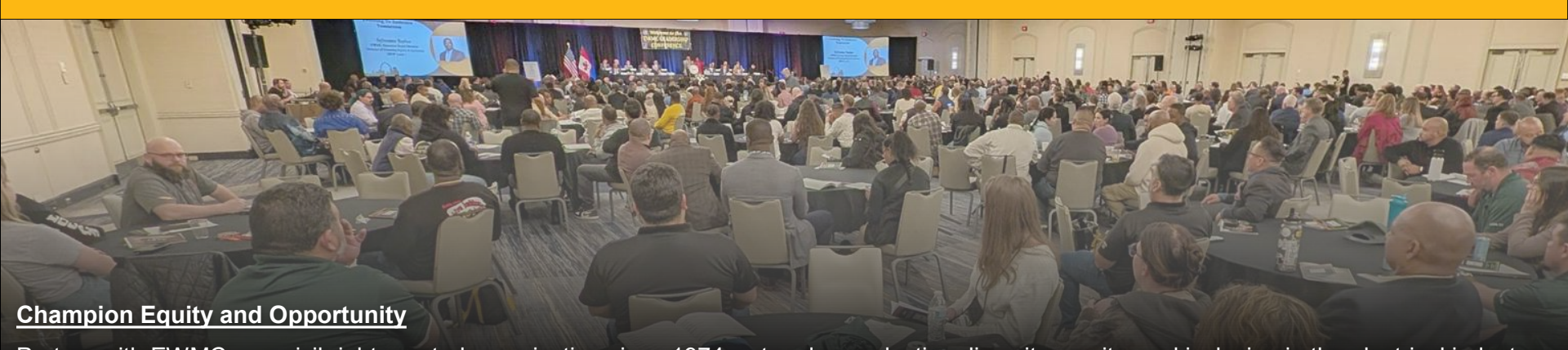

What We Do

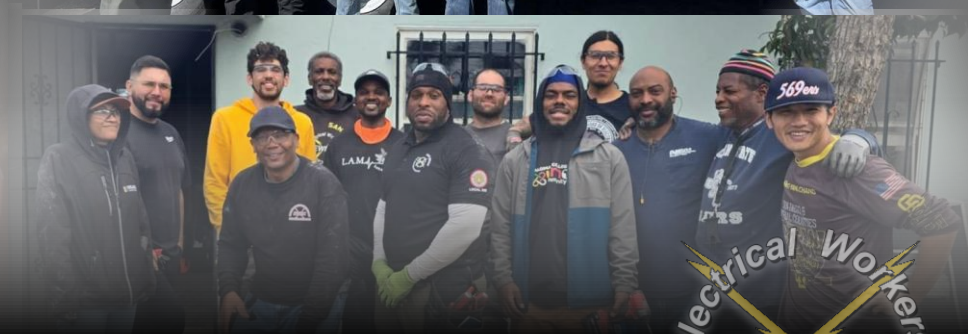
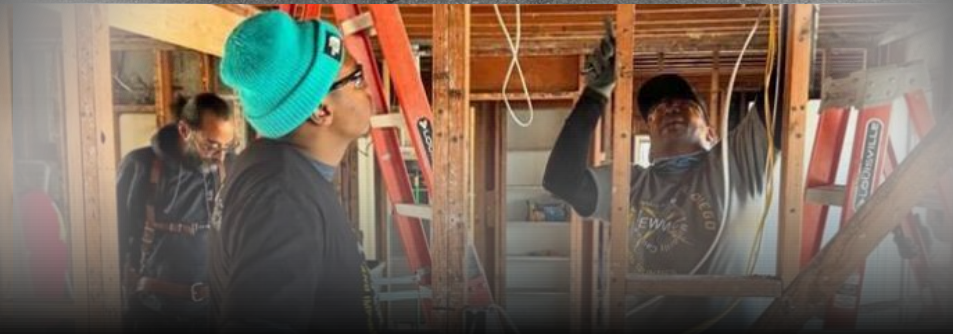


The Electrical Workers Minority Caucus (EWMC) empowers underrepresented IBEW members to lead — on the job, in their union, and in their communities.

3. Chapters build intentional partnerships across their union and local communities to advance shared goals and deepen collective impact.
4. Chapters lead voter registration, education, and mobilization efforts to ensure working families and underrepresented groups have a voice at the ballot box.
5. Chapters foster mentorship programs that connect seasoned members with emerging leaders to strengthen and pass along skills, confidence, and continuity in the labor movement.
6. Chapters adopt local schools to meet student needs and introduce the electrical trade as a rewarding, accessible career path.
7. Chapters advocate for and assist formerly incarcerated individuals in accessing education, training, and union careers that offer a real second chance.
8. Chapters encourage members to fully engage in civic life — from jury duty and volunteering to serving on boards and running for public office.
9. Chapters organize local community service projects and participate in EWMC's annual national Day of Service to uplift and invest in the neighborhoods we call home.
